

# Creating a PubMed search panel

- [Navigate to the panel editor](#)
- Configure the panel as described below
  - Set whether users should be able to close the panel
  - Set whether the panel should appear before or after login, or both
  - Create a title (Mandatory)
  - Create a description (Mandatory)
  - Enter the Search engine URL e.g. [http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/sites/entrez?db=pubmed&cmd=search&holding=<holding\\_code>](http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/sites/entrez?db=pubmed&cmd=search&holding=<holding_code>)
    - Where <holding\_code> is your own organisations code for PubMed
  - Select post
  - You have the option to change the label which appear on the 'Submit' button
  - Click 'Add input box' to configure the free text search field
    - Enter label text for search field
    - Enter a parameter name e.g. 'term' for PubMed
