

Creating an EBSCO discovery service search panel

- [Navigate to the panel editor](#)
- Configure the panel as described below
 - Set whether users should be able to close the panel
 - Set whether the panel should appear before or after login, or both
 - Create a title (Mandatory)
 - Create a description (Mandatory)
 - Enter the Search engine URL: <http://search.ebscohost.com/login.aspx>
 - HTTP method: get
 - You have the option to change the label which appear on the 'Submit' button
 - Enter the 'submit' button value: Search
 - Click 'Add input box' to configure the free text search field
 - Enter label text for search field in 'Box Title'
 - Enter search parameter name: bquery
 - Click 'add hidden parameter' multiple times to add each additional field indicated below.
 - Name: authtype / value: athens
 - Name: direct / value: true
 - Name: scope / value: site
 - Name: site / value: eds-live
 - If you want to limit the results so only full text search results are returned, please include additional hidden parameters:
 - Name: cli0 / value: FT
 - Name: clvo / value: Y


